The Dade County Pharmacy Association is proudly celebrating the 30<sup>th</sup> year presenting the Residency Program. This year we are also offering the required Controlled Substance Validation a 2-hour general CE course, along with 14 hours of General CE for Pharmacists and Technicians plus 12 hours of Consultant Credit on Track 1 and 9 hours of Consultant Credit on Track 2 (plus 2 hr GCE in Oncology and 3 hr GCE in topics on Marijuana in Track 2).
